

TROOP INSTRUCTOR

1. Instruct members of the Troop in Scouting skills as needed.
2. Instruct New Scouts in wood tools safety and fire safety within their first month in the Troop.
3. Work with the PLC in planning meeting programs, arranging for whatever materials may be needed.
4. Work with the Troop Guide(s) and Patrol Leaders in setting up learning situations for the new Scouts to work on Scouting skills and advancement. Recruit additional help when needed.
5. When the Troop is working on a merit badge together, arrange for additional support as needed. Recruit merit badge counselors if unavailable within the Troop.
6. Set a good example, especially in behavior, attendance and leadership. Attend at least 75% of all meetings and 50% of all campouts during my term of office.
7. Enthusiastically wear the uniform correctly as instructed.
8. Live by the Scout Oath and Law.

As Instructor, I promise to do my best to fulfill the requirements of this position throughout the coming period. I understand that my performance in this position will be evaluated by the ASPL and the adult leaders on the basis of my abilities and the job description given above, as well as the demonstration of Scout Spirit and leadership at Troop meetings and other events.
